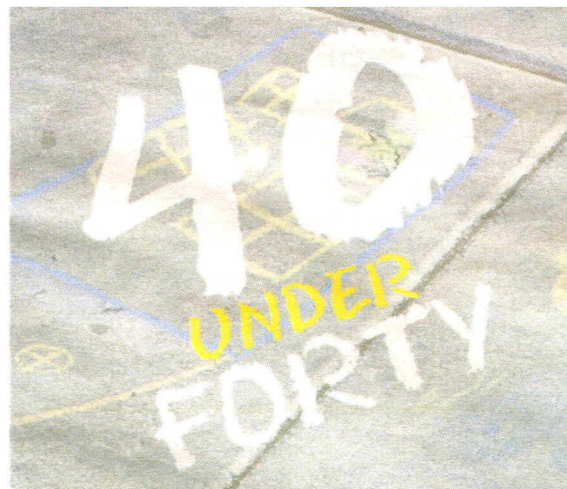
Sure, you have to be good at what you do to be seriously considered for an award, but there's a whole world outside the workplace that often needs help and support, too.
